Prov. 14:21 *“One who despises his neighbor sins, but one who is gracious to the poor is blessed.”*

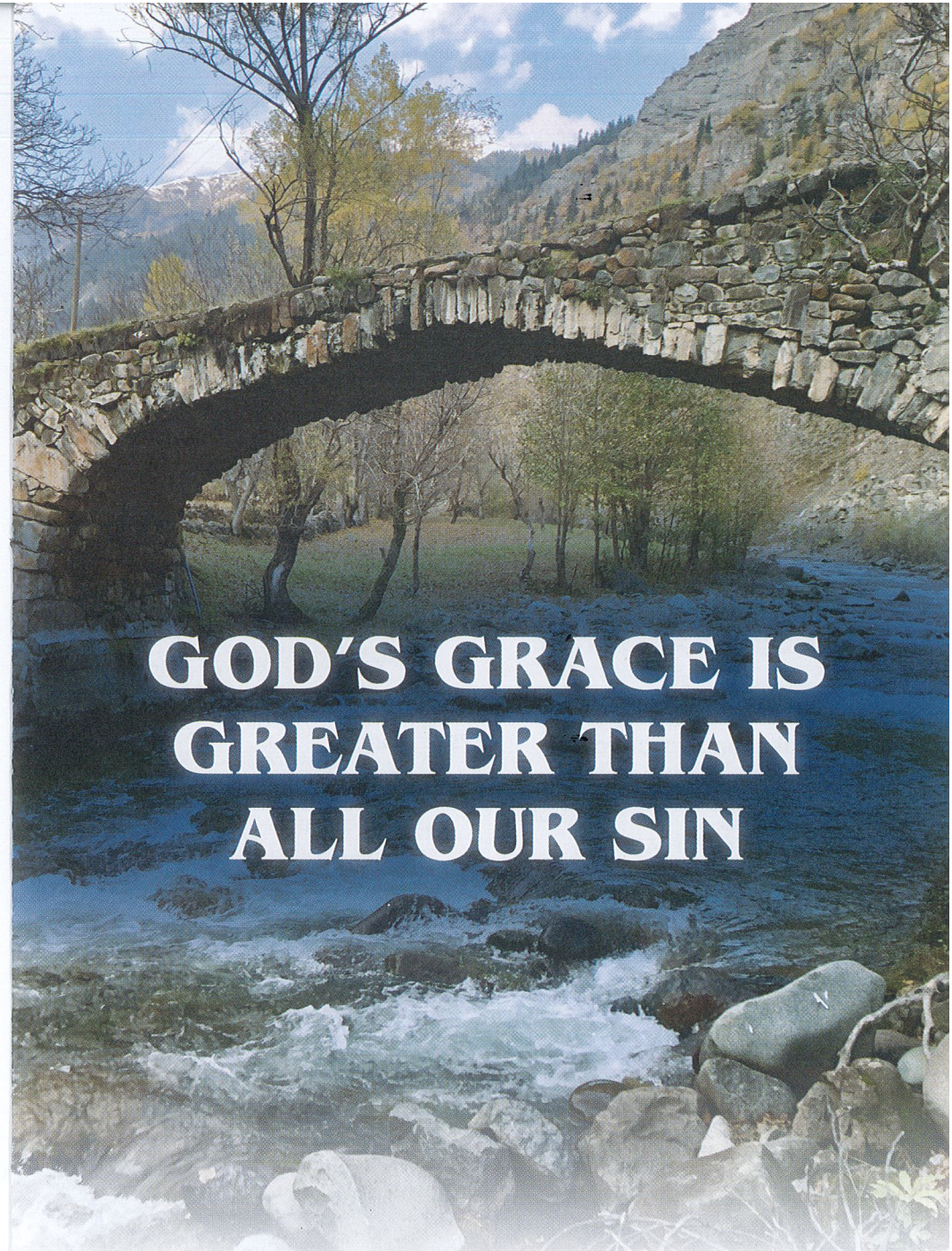
At the Crossroads Refugee Center, we want to express God’s kindness to refugees by meeting physical and spiritual needs.

### PRAISES:

- **Mo...**, an Iranian father with a family of four: more than five years ago, he and his family were in Greece. They came to the Crossroads Center for about a year and became Christians. For the past five years they have been living in Germany and attend a local church there. They visited us this summer to express their appreciation and to share their testimony of how God helped them through the most difficult time of their lives.
- **Na...**, an Iranian mother working for us for the past two years. Recently she was reunited with her husband and children in Germany after nearly five years apart. They are grateful to God—PRAY for them as they now seek asylum.

### PRAYERS:

- Now **working with approx. 200 (families or individuals)** that are supported in one way or another—distribution of grocery cards, gift certificates, grocery bags, clothing, medicine, arrangement for doctor appointments, leading of Bible lessons, offering Christian literature in their language, etc.
- **Alpha and Omega Center:** in Koropi where many Indian and Pakistani refugees live—more people of Muslim and Hindi faiths to find the true eternal Light of our Savior!
- **Crossroads Refugee Center:** monthly financial support is approx. \$3000 per month short of support needed for this year.

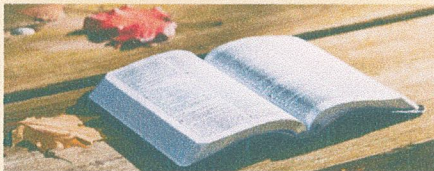
